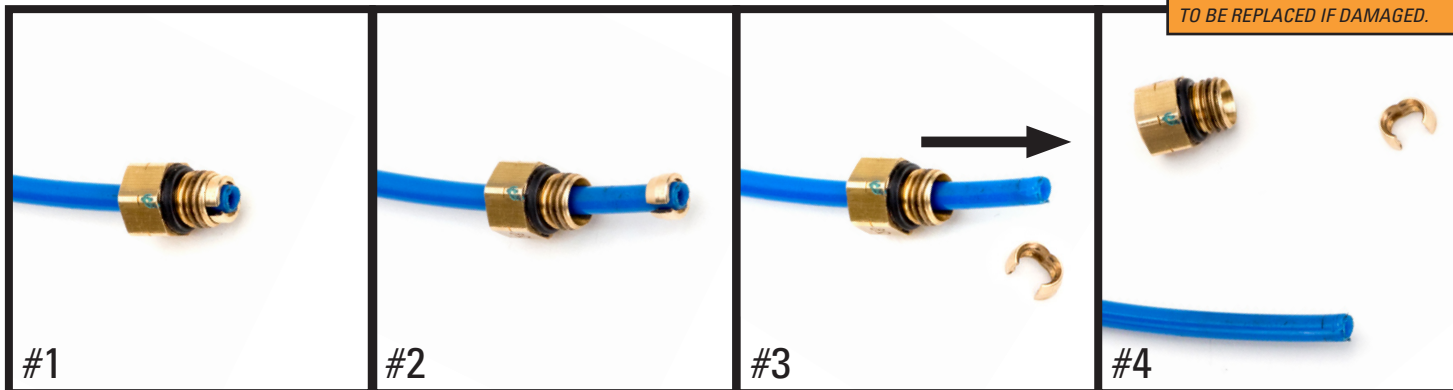

REMOVAL



Prior to inserting the existing air line into the new air fitting you will need to remove the old original equipment air line fitting.

NOTE: SCRATCHES AND/OR DEEP CUTS IN THE AIR LINE CAN RESULT IN POSSIBLE LEAKS. INSPECT THE AIR LINE BEFORE INSERTION. AIR LINE NEEDS TO BE REPLACED IF DAMAGED.



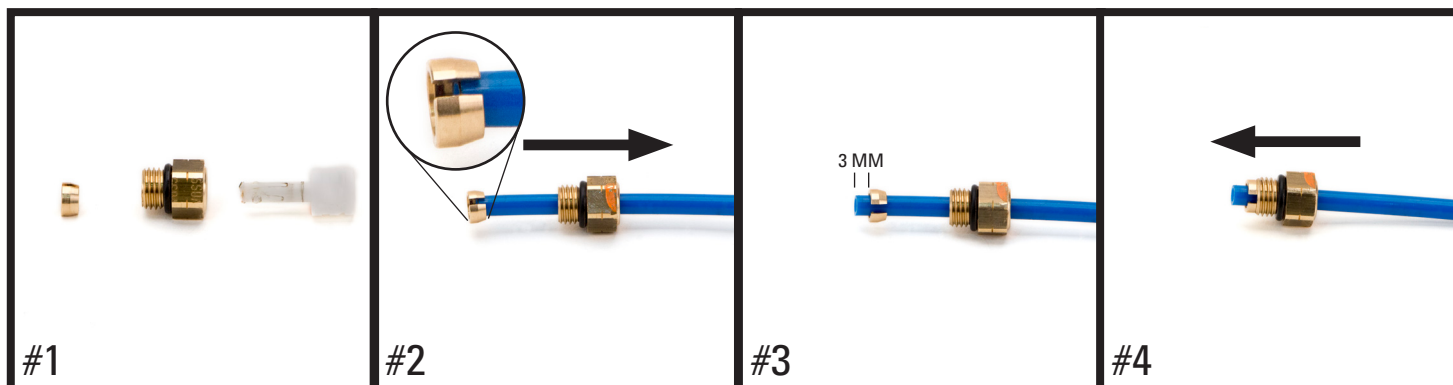
OE AIR LINE FITTING

SLIDE THE THREADED PORTION UP THE LINE AND SPREAD THE COLLET OPEN TO REMOVE

SLIDE THE AIR FITTING OFF OF THE AIR LINE

AIR LINE IS READY FOR INSTALLATION

INSTALLATION - USING THE NEW AIR LINE FITTING PROVIDED IN THE KIT

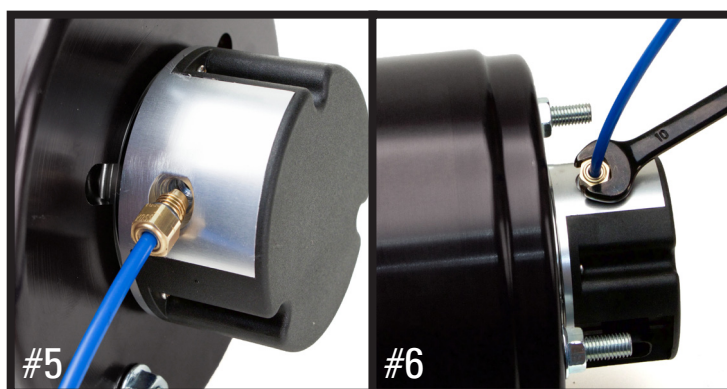


REMOVE AND DISPOSE SHIPPING PIN

INSERT AIR LINE THROUGH FITTING AND COLLET

AIR LINE SHOULD BE APPROX. 3MM BELOW COLLET

PULL AIR FITTING OUTWARD TO LOCK COLLET



INSERT FITTING AND AIRLINE INTO AIR SPRING

TIGHTEN FITTING TO APPROX. 2NM (18 IN-LBS/1.5 FT-LBS)

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
